## REPORT ON ONE-DAY NATIONAL SEMINAR

A one-day National Seminar titled “**Skill Development and Entrepreneurship: A Roadmap to Youth Empowerment in Viksit Bharat**” was successfully organized by the Night College of Arts and Commerce, Kolhapur on 22 January 2026. The seminar aimed to bridge the gap between traditional academic education and the evolving requirements of the global industry to empower the youth for a developed India. The seminar was inaugurated by **Mr. Chandrashekhar Doli**, Chairman of Mayura Steels Pvt. Ltd. In his inaugural address, Mr. Doli emphasized that a degree alone is insufficient in today’s competitive world.
